Suggestions for Activities

- Read a Jewish themed book or story and write about it

- Visit a Jewish museum or exhibit take pictures and write about your experience
- Take a virtual tour of a Jewish museum or Israeli museums and summarize what you learned
- Tikkun Olam Projects –
 - Visit a shelter, nursing facility, Hospital (share the experience with your class)
 - Volunteer your time to work with children (write a paragraph about what you did and why it was important to you)
- Extra hebrew reading
- Attend services and summarize the weekly Parsha
- Hebrew vocabulary study
- Chug Ivrit participation (TBI conversational Hebrew Club)
- Complete a Jewish craft project
- Create a skit or video clip of a skit relating to a torah story
